

## RULES FOR

# THE OUTSTANDING TRACKING CANINE PERPETUAL TROPHY

" a kivalo kovetes kutyafele orokos trofea "

- Open to main, limited, associate and sporting registered dogs
- Owners must be financial members of the Clarence Dog Sports Inc. at the time of the first Clarence Dog Sports Inc Tracking Trial of the year.
- A Point-score Keeper will be nominated by the Tracking sub-committee of the Clarence Dog Sports Inc.
- A Register will be kept.
- Passes must be submitted within one month of the relevant trial.
- Copies of qualifying certificates will be required.
- Dogs must compete in at least one of the Clarence Dog Sports Inc. Tracking Trial in the year.
- Dogs must be handled by their owners.
- The competition will run from 1<sup>st</sup> January to 1<sup>st</sup> November each year.
- Submissions can include all graded tracks in any Tracking Trial and/or Track & Search Trial in any State of Australia. The winner will be the dog that attains the most points based on the following:
  - Pass = 1
  - Good = 2
  - Very Good = 3
  - Excellent = 4
- Each Pass will also receive 1 point (*January 2012*)
- If there is a tie the final result will be decided by a count back based on the most number of excellent scores, then the most very good scores etc.
- If there is still a tie it will then be decided by the highest tracks done from TD7 to TD1 and Track & Search 6 – 1
- Any changes to the abovementioned rules must be unanimously decided by the Tracking Sub-Committee.
